Regular Meeting

Mayor Sanders called the special meeting to order at 11:45 a.m. Alderman Whitley led the invocation and Mayor Pro Tem Thompson led the pledges.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 1 convene into closed session on the following:

- a. Pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Section 551. 074 of the Texas Government Code – Personnel Matters – Discussion and possible action on the employment of Eddie Jimenez. (placed by Mayor Sanders)
- b. Pursuant to Open Meeting Act, Chapter 551, Section 551. 074 of the Texas Government Code – Personnel Mattes – Discussion and possible action on the employment of Robin Deville. (placed by Mayor Sanders)

Mr. Jimenez and Mrs. Deville both wanted closed session.

A motion to convene into closed session was made by Alderwoman Jircik. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Thompson, all were in favor and the motion carried. Council convened into closed session at 11:48 a.m.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 2 reconvene into open session and take action, if necessary, on closed items. A motion to reconvene into open session and take action if necessary was made by Mayor Pro Tem Thompson. The motion was seconded by Alderman Whitley. Council reconvened into open session at 12:00 p.m. and took the following action:

- a. A motion to discontinue the employment of Eddie Jimenez was made by Alderman Whitley. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Thompson, all were in favor and the motion carried. Mayor Sanders informed Mr. Jimenez that his employment with the City would not continue. Mr. Jimenez asked if he could know why and Mayor Sanders informed that Council was not satisfied with his performance and felt he had not done what they wanted.
- b. A motion to hire Robin Deville as Maintenance & Repair Foreman was made by Alderman Whitley. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jircik, all were in favor and the motion carried. Mayor Sanders informed Mrs. Deville that the pay was the same for the Operator and the Foreman. Council asked Mrs. Deville if she was interested in doing the Operator and the Foreman job at which Mrs. Deville answered she would do it to the best of her ability.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 3 discussion and possible action on sending Mark Hainley and Robin Deville to the Surface Water Production I Class on February 3 through February 5, 2015 in Baytown. A motion to send both Mark and Robin to the class was made by Mayor Pro Tem Thompson. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jircik, all were in favor and the motion carried.

With no further business needed to be brought before Council, Mayor Sanders moved to item 4 and asked for a motion to adjourn. A motion to adjourn was made by Mayor Pro Tem Thompson. The motion was seconded by Alderman Whitley, all were in favor and the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 12:06 p.m.
