Mayor Sanders called the workshop to order at 12:10 p.m. Mayor Pro Tem led the invocation and the pledges.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 1 discuss the proposal 2018-2019 fiscal year budget.

Mayor, Council, and staff discussed the proposed budget. Mr. Grigsby informed Council that he had not yet figured the tax rate information, but that he would be working on that over the weekend and within the next week.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 2 discuss Ordinance No. 2018-07-02 pertaining to special events. Mayor Sanders informed Council that she had spoken with Sheriff Hawthorne and he suggested that the City require a police officer for every 5,000 patrons and the Chamber of Commerce reimburse the County Sheriff Department at their overtime rate. It was also discussed that all vendors must pull a permit with the City and the cost of the permit be \$5.00, this would include the citizens that plan to park vehicles on their properties.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 3 discuss Ordinance No. 2018-07-01 pertaining to portable restrooms.

Council made some changes to the ordinance.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 4 discuss janitorial services for City Hall.

Council discussed the options and asked staff to contact the City insurance company regarding the company hired for janitorial services having or not having insurance or being bonded.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 5 discuss any other business that needs to be brought before Council. No other business was discussed.

With no further business needed to be brought before the council the workshop was adjourned at 1:20 p.m.
