Mayor Sanders called the workshop to order at 6:49 p.m. Alderman Thompson led the invocation and Alderman Anderson led the pledges.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 1 discussion of proposed Resolution No. 2015-02-02 – A resolution of the City Council of Anahuac, Texas fully supporting the IKE DIKE Concept being proposed by Texas A & M University-Galveston. After discussion Council asked for this item to be placed on the next meeting agenda

Mayor Sanders moved to item 2 discussion of proposed Ordinance No. 2015-03-03 – An ordinance amending Chapter 90: Health and Sanitation; Nuisances prohibiting clutter and refuse with the City limits. Council was happy with the updates made to the Ordinance and asked for this item to also be placed on the agenda for next meeting.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 3 discussion of proposed Ordinance No. 2015-03-04 – An ordinance of the City of Anahuac, Texas regulating the use and operation of Golf Carts. After discussion and reviewing the Ordinance Council asked that this Ordinance be placed on the next agenda.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 4 discussion regarding payment of past due amounts to Fire Department. Council informed Mr. Bays this was something he take care of and asked for it to be placed on the next agenda for an update.

Mayor Sanders moved to item 5 discussion on the concept of consent agenda. Mr. Bays informed Council the concept of the consent agenda was to help make the meetings shorter.
