

DECLARATION OF DISASTER FOR THE CITY OF ANAHUAC

WHEREAS, the **City of Anahuac** on the 25th day of August, 2017, is under imminent threat of r severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from

**THE THREAT OF HURRICANE FORCE WINDS, TORNADOES, FLOODING
AND OTHER WEATHER RELATED CONDITIONS FROM HURRICANE HARVEY;**


and

WHEREAS, the **Mayor of Anahuac** has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ANAHUAC :

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for **the City of Anahuac** pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of **Anahuac**.
3. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the **City Secretary**.
4. Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the **City Emergency Management Plan**.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
