

## VOLUNTARY EVACUATION

Whereas, by proclamation on August 24, 2017 the County Judge has declared that a State of Disaster exists for Chambers County, Texas resulting from the

### THREAT OF HURRICANE HARVEY

WHEREAS, said State of Disaster requires that certain emergency measures be taken pursuant to Texas Statute 418 and the Governor's Executive Order Relating to Emergency Management; now, therefore, the following regulation shall take effect immediately upon issuance and shall remain in effect until the State of Disaster is terminated:

A VOLUNTARY EVACUATION recommended as of 4:00pm on Thursday August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017, which includes all of the following locations:

Smith Point, Chambers County, Texas

Cedar Point, Chambers County, Texas

All Recreational Vehicle Parks and sites

All unanchored mobile homes

Any low lying areas which are known to have flooded.

All of the residents of these locations should consider evacuating to higher ground or inland into areas of the State which are not forecast to be impacted by the flood waters or high winds from Hurricane Harvey.
